

Prof. Jan J.P. de Goede, citizen of the Kingdom of the Netherlands, Senior Principal, Tax Knowledge Management reporting directly to the CEO of IBFD, held several positions during his 19 years of work at IBFD including Director of the Knowledge Centre with 65 tax specialists from more than 30 countries. He is currently responsible for Tax Knowledge Management and performs various academic, teaching and government consultancy activities, is liaison officer for relations with OECD (former member Working Party 1), UN (member Sub Committees on Taxation of Extractive Industries and on Dispute Avoidance, member Eminent Expert Group on Tax Policy and Public Expenditure of ESCAP) and ICC (member Tax Committee). He is Professor of International and European Tax Law at Lodz University in Poland, and visiting professor of the Renmin University of China in Beijing and of the Financial University under the Government of the Russian Federation in Moscow, and teaches at other universities and Institutes, including in Sao Paulo, Leiden, Amsterdam and Maastricht. He chaired several Asian Tax Authorities Symposia (attended by 23 Asia-Pacific countries) and chaired or participated in many international seminars/ meetings. He is member of the International Fiscal Association (attending its Permanent Scientific Committee as supervisor of the IFA researcher in which capacity he supervised more than 25 extensive research papers on various tax topics), of the European Association of Tax Law Professors and of the Dutch Association for Tax Science. Previously he worked for 19 years at the Dutch Ministry of Finance, including as Head of the Divisions on Company Tax Legislation and on Bilateral Tax Treaties. He was granted the Medal for Science and Society of Lodz University and is a Knight in the Order of Merit of the Republic of Poland.
